Course Description – Bancruptcy Law

Course Title: Bankruptcy Law

Course Credits: 6

Language of Instruction: Albanian

Course Description: This course is a study of bancruptcy legilsation and practices, as they relate to judgments and administration of insolvent companies. The students will have an opportunity to understand the written bancruptcy law, discuss domestic and international standards, and solve hypothecials. The course will be delivered through the classical method of classroom lectures and seminars, but interactive methods will be integrated in them to make this course more accessible, to the students.

Course Goals: After completing this course, students should be able to know and analyze the laws applicable to creditors' rights and bankruptcy in general.

Course Requirements: Failure to attend at least 25% of seminars means the students cannot enter the final exam. The exam might be taken in the fall semester. The student is required to take active participation in seminars.

Grading: The final grade will be determined based on a maximum score of 100 points. These will be collected in the following way:

- Maximum 30 points for contributions to seminars;
- Maximum 70 points for a final oral exam.

Course Schedule: The course includes 45 hours of lectures and 15 hours of seminars. Lectures will be delivered bi-weekly. The schedule of activities is subject to change.
