Course Title: Multinational Business Finance

Course Description: This course aims to examine decision-making in international business finance, more precisely in multinational business finance, through a detailed study of opportunities and challenges encountered when business operations extend overseas. Emphasis is put in the need to change conventional financial models to adjust to the global market and maximize multinational companies 'value.

Course Goals: The goal of this course is to provide students with core knowledge on the financial management of international companies with an emphasis on multinational companies. At the end of the course, students will be able to deal with FX markets, with exposure to the currency risk and the underlying hedging methods, to raise capital in the global financial markets as well as to evaluate international projects from a global perspective.

Course Requirements: During the course, the students must participate in one midterm test, prepare 2 short course assignments, as well as do a final exam at the end of the course. They are also expected to be active during seminar hours by taking part in discussions in class solving problems and exercises within these hours.
