**Course Title: Tourism laws**

Language of Instruction: Albanian/English

**Course Description**: The subject is classified in "Compulsory discipline and general education" and includes the simultaneous treatment of the principles of civil law in general and property and the law of obligations in particular. Students are offered theoretical and practical knowledge on property law issues, other real rights and contractual law issues.

**Course Goals**: The goals of the subject consist in giving students the opportunity to better understand the field of civil law and specifically tourism law, to develop the students' awareness of the implementation of the provisions that regulate matters in the respective fields. Students will have the opportunity to solve the tasks required in the field of tourism law with a logical and analytical approach. The students will develop skillful critical approach to the law and legal argumentation in the field of property law and in the field of contract law.

**Course Requirements**: For the student is mandatory to attend 75 % of seminars. Evaluation during the course is based on oral control of the knowledge as well on case law presented during the course.

**Grading**: The control is based on 30/100 points during the seminars, through continuous evaluation and collegiums, as well as the course project or assignment. While the final exam, which will be written 70/100.
