**Course Title: Tourism planning and development.**

## Language of Instruction: Albanian/English

**Course Description**: This subject provides students with basic knowledge of: the concept of a country's development, the characteristics of the non -development of a country, the role of tourism as an important tool for the development of a country, the concept and the need for tourism development sustainably as a very important direction in the development and management of tourism, applicable in all segments of the tourism industry sector, the role of the public and private sector for sustainable tourism development, the directions of successful tourism planning and development.

**Course Goals**: Main aims is to enable students as future managers to contribute to the implementation of sustainability in tourism business activities or future politics in the field of tourism.
