Language of Instruction: French

Course Description: This course aims to to teach and deepen students' knowledge of the subject of French history, the connection of history with all other fields of study, thus showing the influence of history in the entire development of the French people. At the same time, this syllabus aims to provide students with concrete knowledge about the events of the French people from prehistoric times, the medieval period to our days, thus making a chronological study of all events, successes and defeats.

Course Goals: Students must first know the general history of Europe in different eras in order to be able to position France on the big historical map. They will learn about the history of the French people from the period when France did not yet have a name, a language or an autochthonous people, to move on to the power struggles, to the creation of the first governments and monarchies, the European and world wars and further in the major economic, social and political developments. He should also learn about the great revolutions and the impact that the history of France has had on the entire European and world history.

The student must fix the main concepts such as: prehistory, middle ages, monarchy, war, revolution, evolution, republic, presidency, modern times, etc.
