Course Title: Integrated skills in French language 2

Language of Instruction: French

Course Description: This course aims to train students at a higher level in the four basic language competencies defined by the European Reference Framework for language learning, such as: listening, reading, speaking and writing.

The students are worked on linguistic knowledge, cultural topics and social issues related to France and making constant comparisons with their country. These topics have been selected in such a way that each student has the opportunity and space to express and share with others opinions, experiences or emotions, continuously improving knowledge.

Students develop skills in reading/listening and understanding written and audio materials; expressive skills in both speaking and writing, including description, reasoned discussion, analysis, and argumentation.

Course Goals: Work on the four skills of the European Framework of Reference: listening, reading, speaking, and writing.

- Work on grammatical, cultural and social knowledge.
- Develop listening, reading and writing skills
- Describe, discuss, analyze, and argue about different topics.

The main topics worked with the students will deal with daily life, professional life, technology, culture, entertainment, communication and new approaches to social problematic. Other topics are about health and social security, holidays and celebrations in France, bilingualism, old traditions and customs and their impact on our day life, etc.
