Course Title: Developmental Psychology 1

**Course Credits: 9 ECTS** 

Language of Instruction: Albanian

Course Description: The treatment of human development enables the student to acquire knowledge about the changes that humans undergo in biological, physical, social and psychological aspects, seeing these in relation to genetic, family, social and wider factors. In this course, the student is introduced to the scientific bases of the study and application of knowledge on human development, to the quantitative and qualitative changes that the latter undergoes, to the variations of these changes as a result of the interaction with environmental and hereditary factors and with psychological theories more dominant over development.

**Course Goals**: At the end of the Developmental Psychology course student must have: 1) Acquired basic concepts and knowledge on human development in biological, physical, social and psychological aspects; 2) Cultivated and developed a scientific attitude and interest towards the problems of human development, which enables the student to develop critical thinking on these problems;

**Course Requirements**: To complete the course students will be required to (1) take one midterm exam, (2) take one final exam, (3) present paper.

**Grading**: Presentation 20 points; Midterm 20 points; Final Exam 60 points

Course Schedule: 2 hours lectures & 1 hour seminar /week. Total=30 weeks
