Course Title: GENDER STUDIES

Course Credits: 4

Language of Instruction: Albanian

Course Description: The course examines how gender roles and stereotypes affect the individual's psychological and emotional well-being, his family, social, political and decision-making relationships. The course will clarify the cultural meanings of the terms female and male, the meanings that society creates about how each gender should behave, the connection of gender stereotypes with the differential power relationship between men and women, the influence of gender stereotypes in limiting individual functioning and negative effects on human relations and society.

Course Goals: The objective of the course is to equip the student with general knowledge in the field of Gender Studies.

Course Requirements: The final assessment will be reflected in the amount of points that students have accumulated based on the following:

- Active participation in the seminars hours 15 points (maximum).
- -Course assignment 20 points (maximum).
- -First settlement- 30 points (maximum).
- -Second settlement-35 points (maximum).

Grading: Grade 10 (95-100 points); Grade 9 (85-95 points); Grade 8 (75-85 points); Grade 7 (65-75 points); Grade 6 (55-65 points); Grade 5 (45-55 points); Grade 4 (less than 45 points).

Course Schedule: This course takes place in the Second semester, with weekly academic workload 2/1 (two hours lectures, one hours seminars). Lecturesa are facultative and seminars attendance is mandatory not less than 75% of hours.
