Course Description:

The stages in which the study of the Albanian language has gone since Frang Bardhi (1635) who with his dictionary marks the first work on Albanian until the end of the 20th century constitute the object of the "History of Albanian Linguistics (Albanology)". While according to the linguistic disciplines, the chronological review of the studies carried out in the relevant field will be done, focusing on the most representative works and authors. The lectures are based on the monograph "Albanology" vol. I, by prof. Jup Kastrati and "History of Albanian Linguistics" (Albanology)" by prof. David Luke, as well as in studies on the works "Latin-Albanian Dictionary" by F. Bardhi, "Historical Grammar of the Albanian Language" by Sh. Demiraj, "Dialectological Atlas of Albanian", "Etymological Studies in the Field of Albanian" by E. Çabej etc.

Course Goals:

The Albanology course is aimed at forming knowledge about works and authors who have dealt with the study of Albanian, starting from lexicographic, grammatological, dialectological, onomastic works, but also about the journey of the alphabet and the spelling of Albanian. "History of Albanian Linguistics "(Albanology)" aims to list the studies about Albanian. The subject is conceived according to linguistic disciplines, starting with the earliest in the field of Albanian, lexicography, up to the definition of the Albanian standard.
