## **Sample Course Description**

Course Title: History of Linguistics
Course Credits: 5 ECTS
Language of Instruction: Albanian

**Course Description**: This aim of this course is to deepen the theoretical background of students, to make a history of the development of linguistic from ancient times and to continue with linguistic achievements throughout the centuries. Students will be able to understand linguistic evolution in specific periods, to identify the methodological approaches of different linguistic directions and of particular scholars, starting from Antiquity to the 19<sup>th</sup> century XXI.

**Course Goals**: Upon the completion of the course, students should be able to:

- study the history of linguistic studies starting with the earliest linguistic theories;

- interpret linguistic thesis of Swiss linguist, F. De Saussure;

- know European and American structural schools to reach the linguistic patterns of Chomsky and new approaches to the last century XXI century.

**Course Requirements**: During this course, students must be active during the seminar sessions with discussions (10 points), must undergo a partial control (15 points) and must prepare a course assignment (15 points).

Grading: Written Exam 60 %, Coursework 40 %.

Course Schedule: Course frequency is 75%.

Linguistic thought in Ancient India, Ancient Greece and Rome. The development of linguistic thought in the Middle Ages and Renaissance. Historical and comparative linguistics of the 19th century's. Saussurean linguistics. Structuralism in linguistics. Linguistic School of Prague, London and Danish School of Copenhagen. American linguistics: F. Boas, E. Sepir and their theory. N. Chomsky. Transformational and generative grammar. Universal languages etc.
